

Montclair to install first public electric car charging stations in N.J.

MONTCLAIR — Montclair will be the first of four municipalities in the state to charge up electric cars with charging stations, funded by a \$25,000 grant from Walmart, according to a report by NorthJersey.com.

The stations will be located in a parking lot, and recharge battery-powered vehicles, said the report. Both private and municipal vehicles will be allowed to use the station.
